

## Annual General Meeting of the Graduate Students Committee

Students from no less than 10 Canadian universities attended the Annual General Meeting of the Graduate Student Committee held on 31 May 2010 in Montreal. Here are the highlights of the meeting. First, the results from our general election were announced. Valérie Lapointe-Gagnon, from Université Laval, was elected co-president of the GSC, she replaces Olivier Côté whose term was ending. Chris Miller (Concordia University) and Émilie Pigeon (University of Ottawa) volunteered their services to fill the vacant positions of treasurer and webmaster respectively. They replaced Jess Dunkin (Carleton University) and Jonathan Crossen (University of Waterloo). We wish to thank the outgoing representatives for their implication on the Graduate Student Committee.

The General Assembly decided, through two resolutions adopted unanimously, to strengthen the role of treasurer in the committee, particularly in the search of new financial resources with students associations, universities, history departments and academic presses. Indeed, the GSC no longer enjoys stable financial revenues since the Guide to Teaching Assistants in History is available online.

Moreover, it was decided to diversify the means by which the GSC reaches its members by using new social networks in addition to its listserv. A greater effort will also be exerted to enhance the status of the GSC in student-led conferences.

Finally, Jean-François Lozier (University of Toronto), GSC liaison with the CHA, brought us up to date on the Robarts Library issue who now charge students from outside the University of Toronto costly charges to consult its library.
