OBITUARY

Robert J. Surtees ("Bob"), professor of history at Nipissing University, passed away sudently on August 25 at age 61. Bob started teaching at Nipissing the year it was founded (1967). A specialist in Canadian Native history his first book was The Original People (1971). His doctoral thesis remains a standard reference in the history of Ontario's Indian treaties. He collaborated on *The Atlas of Great Lakes Indian History*. His other works include *Canadian Indian Policy: A Critical Bibliography* (1982), *The Northern Connection: Ontario Northland Since 1902* (1992) and a number of articles. Bob also worked as a consultant on Aboriginal issues, and with the Newberry Library in Chicago. Love of teaching made him a favourite of students. Not surprisingly, he was named a "Popular Prof" by Maclean's Magazine. Most importantly, Bob Surtees was a generous and giving person who will be sorely missed by his family (his wife Margaret and their seven daughters), colleagues, friends and students.
